BABIES, TODDLERS, PRESCHOOLERS:

Classes are held once a week, for **5 weeks (July 2-31)**, for 40 minutes, and limited to 12 children, plus their parents/caregivers.

“WIGGLERS & WOBBLERS” ~ ’18 & ’19

We’ll have fun with songs & rhymes for clapping, tickling, bouncing, and finding toes & belly buttons. There’ll be instruments for them to explore aurally *and* orally, plus puppets, scarves for peekaboo, and little dances, until lullaby time brings a soothing close. **Tue 11:00, Wed 11:00**

“WANDERERS” ~ born in ’17

We try to keep pace with their boundless energy with clapping, bouncing, tickling and peek-a-boo songs, as well as finding toes & noses. There’ll be instruments to tap & shake, plus scarves to dance with, and puppets that “bzz” or “moo”. But even they need a lullaby or two! **Tue 9:30, Wed 9:30**

“MOVERS & SHAKERS” ~ born in ’16

Now we add songs & rhymes for budding imaginations! They’ll explore a wealth of global instruments, plus scarves to dance with, musical books, and puppets, until it’s time to rock a Teddy to sleep. **Wed 10:15**

“FAMILY MUSIC” ~ all ages!

There’s no age limit; all that’s needed is an interest in having fun making music together! Families/caregivers with just one child are welcome, too. **Tue 10:15**

INTEGRATED ARTS CAMPS (JK – Gr 3):

Every afternoon, a different adventure, through **Music** (singing games, playing rhythms on drums, xylophones and just about anything that can be struck, shaken, or rubbed to make sound), **Drama, Dance, Art** (painting, drawing, sculpture, collage), and stories! **Drop-off** is from **1:00 – 1:15**, and **pick-up** from **3:45 - 4:00**. All camps will be led by a Master “Orff” teacher (**Jodie**) and limited to just **12** participants. *Themed snacks are included*, but you might want to bring a smock ☺.

“WHETHER THE WEATHER BE...”

~ for children born in ’13 – ’15

Cloudy with a chance of meatballs? Every afternoon a different outlook. We’ll dance up a blizzard, go singing in the rain, paint a rainbow, and bake sun bread! **July 8-12**

“Z IS FOR ZIPPER!”

~ for children born in ’13 – ’15

Through music, movement, drama, arts & crafts, and stories about hats, shoes, mittens, wool, buttons & zippers, we’ll explore the wonderful world of clothes! Themed snacks will be included - fruit leather, anyone? **July 15-19**

“GLOBAL ADVENTURES”

~ for children born in ’11 – ’13

Every afternoon we’ll explore a different part of the world. We might play drums on Safari in Africa one day, jump with the kangaroos and decorate boomerangs the next, then go to a Mexican Fiesta (no Siestas allowed!). **July 22-26**

LOCATION:

~ ST. JOHN'S NORWAY CHURCH, 470 Woodbine Ave., just N of Kingston Rd. (Free parking on site).

FEES:

~ Classes: \$90 (10% sibling discount off 2nd & 3rd enrollment - \$81)
~ Camps: \$198/wk

There is no charge for infants to attend their older sibling's class if younger than 4 months at the start of the term. Otherwise, they may be registered at a 10% discount. *If an older child is registered in one of the camps, they may attend their younger sibling's class free of charge during the week(s) they are enrolled in camp. Otherwise, their attendance can be pro-rated for pre-arranged "drop-ins". (Please email to arrange this.)*

Placement can only be confirmed once payment is received. NSF cheques are subject to a \$25 handling fee. In the case of withdrawals, notice must be received in writing, and there is an administrative fee of \$30 plus the pro-rated amount for any classes that have taken place. For camps, there will be *no refunds after July 1st, unless they are cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.*

Missed classes can be made up within this term, if there is room in an appropriate age group, and by prior arrangement.
